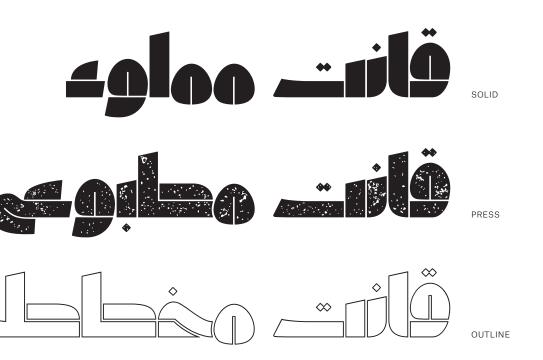

STYLES



Kanat is a display family that dialogues between digital and moveable type technologies. It is best used from size 48pt and above and is meant to highlight words playfully or to use them as an architectural space.

Kanat Outline allows for overlays with the Solid version. And Kanat Press echoes the warmth and texture of its sister wood typeface.

Kanat Solid was initially drawn in 2017 to be CNC-milled by Rutger Paets into the Kanat wood typeface. It is housed at the [typo]Grafische Werkplaats Amsterdam [GWA].

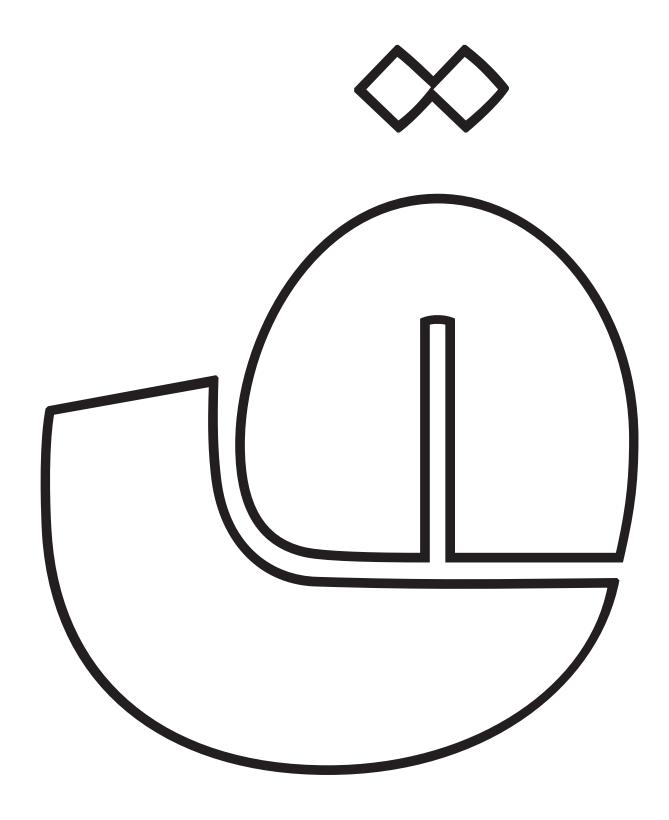
The design sprung from a question: How to create an Arabic wood type-face that embraces both Arabic script tradition and the letterpress's constraint of having letters fit into a physical, rectangular block? As a result, the Kanat family is based on one of the earliest forms of Arabic calligraphy [a style generally known as Primary Kufic] and is fully detached to optimize itself for moveable type technology. The typeface is a homage to Wiek Molin, the late director of the GWA who, along with current director Corine Elemans, were the initiators of the wood-type project. Kanat is the Turkish word for "the wing."



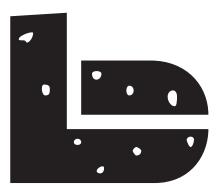

### ABOUT THE DESIGNER

Lara Captan is an independent type designer and typographer based in Amsterdam. She spent years studying the vast and culturally rich field of Arabic script. She developed individual methods and techniques to make new digital typefaces that both adhere to the original written script and bring them to the current time and modern technology. She also co-developed her unique educational program to teach these methods and techniques to existing and aspiring Arabic type designers.

Lara holds a BFA in Graphic Design from the American University of Beirut (2006), a Masters in Advanced Typography from the Escola de Disseny i Art (Barcelona, 2011), and a Certificate in Type Design from the Cooper Union (New York, 2012). She taught design and typography at the American University of Beirut between 2006 and 2013 then moved to The Netherlands where she has been creating Arabic typefaces for multiple technologies and practising multi-disciplinary design. She enjoys regularly speaking at conferences and giving workshops around the world.
